1. What previous experience have you had in the area in which you are applying for?

I was involved in a percussion ensemble in High School competing at an international level, and was fortunate to lead a group of hardworking and ambitious individuals into taking the bronze home. To combat with the loneliness issue, I think holding more events or activities for CSULA students would allow students to become more involve at school and make more friends. An example would be the Korean Festival that was held this early October. I noticed that so many students came out because of this festival. Having more events that interest the students would allow students to become more active and promote student welfare in terms of student activity involvement. Lastly, the lack of promotion for assistance or resources is one of the problems I faced in my first year at CSULA. I was very confused with departments and no one explained anything to me. I want to help students have more attainability and accessibility with resources and assistance from advisors or graduate students.

The LA Times reported in 2016 that only 19% of incoming students graduate on time. I think we need to explore and investigate why are our students not graduating in time, and what need to do to support them while at CSULA. Second, there also seems to be a problem with classes not being open for students and students are being left out of signing in for courses. This could be one of the problems of the graduating rate, and it needs to be solved. Also, students of color are still facing difficulties navigating this system.
