I want to be able to help organizations get enough funds for their events without going against policies and rules, so struggling student officers of campus organizations who have problems towards providing for themselves do not have to go through this situation of taking out money from their own pocket.

I have volunteered at the Rosemead Public Library for 4 years. I've helped organized and scanned books, helped in the process of delivering them to other locations, served on the Teen Advisory Board which is what maintains, managed, and hosted the teen events and workshops at the library, and also assisted with running the Summer Reading Program for both children and teens over the summers.
