- iii. **Diana Chavez:** I do encourage everyone to do presentations in the beginning of the semester in classes so students can know who you are. I see Jocelyn's common, is discord actually really worth it? I have no knowledge of that so maybe actually having meetings on discord.
- iv. **Jocelyn Vargas:** I don't think it has to be office hours it can also be other events but I think before someone mentioned that zoom is tied to school now so we can switch platform for other events, so it won't associate with negative feelings.
- v. **Ledi Loot:** It is very prone to people using curse words and it also is sometimes used for cheating, but a lot of students use discord for gaming buy office hours not sure but google hangouts maybe.
- vi. **Dena Florez:** You mentioned a newsletter you are developing so maybe let's put your work there and get it out.
- vii. **Ledi Loot:** I also found that connecting with faculty really helps or even professors and if you need a directory, I have been willing to share it with you
- viii. **Jocelyn Vargas:** Is there are way to collaborate with CSI on getting emails and dates and times for club and org meetings and ask if we can stop by.
- ix. **Ledi Loot:** We tried that approach, and we couldn't do it but what we can do is go to Instagram and they post all the active student organizations and their meeting ID's.
- x. **Diana Chavez:** So maybe college reps can reach out to college specific clubs and have a short presentation of what they do, and we can also have Tyler or Kayla give you information on club funding. Second, I think to get more people on our newsletter is to just have my face on the first page I think that would work.
- xi. **Ledi Loot:** If you look at our Instagram you will see the organizations we follow, and they post all their events on their page and you can join like I have and advertise, and it is very accessible.
