- **Diana Chavez:** Diana asks for feedback about spring programming and mentions that Barnaby has made a programming plan.
- **Barnaby Peake:** Barnaby goes over plans and ideas for programming.
- **Diana Chavez:** Do you have ideas or need help in programming ideas?
- **Josue Montenegro:** Josue mentions that he had his financial literacy workshop and wants to have another in the spring.
- **Diana Chavez:** The program proposal should be sent now. Even if you don't have a set date for your program still submit the proposal and say that the time and date is tentative.
- **Jose Montenegro:** Since I did it through zoom do I have an option to do it through zoom spring semester?
- **Diana Chavez:** We set the expectation that all programming will be in person, but I am open to virtual events. Programmers are required to do two in person. Any other questions.
- **Amber Beasley:** Amber makes a point to make some programs hybrid.
- **Diana Chavez:** Diana agrees.

➤ **ASI Repopulation- The committee will discuss updates on repopulating ASI for the next spring.**

- **Diana Chavez:** Diana Chavez reminds members about completing a survey and express member concerns and asks for the committees' thoughts.
- **Sasha Prakir:** In my area I think they are okay with in person although they prefer online because of Friday meetings, and I would prefer online for at least my meeting, but I will go with what we all choose.
- **Diana Chavez:** Sasha you are more than welcome to change your time and day of bylaws to a different day and time. Do you know why your committee would prefer it to be online?
- **Sasha Prakir:** Well 9 AM on a Friday is rough but it is not only bylaws but let's same that some of your members are sick and you can't make quorum you can just make the meeting virtual, and it can be more flexible.
- **Diana Chavez:** I want to move away from personal preference and when it comes to meetings its already hard to be hybrid. I do agree that we need a virtual component so it can be accessible to everyone so we can broadcast so everyone can tune. I know that there has been a problem in housing, and I know that we are going to hold a meeting at housing, so students don't have to wait to come to us.
- **Amber Beasley:** It was shared to me that some of the senators may have to drop if it was going to be fully in person.

- **Diana Chavez:** Do you know why?
- **Amber Beasley:** I think the idea of running from class to a meeting doesn't work with their schedule, but I do know that it is important to be on campus.
- **Angelina Gomez:** My commissioners are excited to come back. I feel like there should be a grace period to get to meetings for those who are new.
- **Diana Chavez:** Any other concerns?
- **Analiz Marmolejo:** I think Sasha brings up a good point on Friday meetings because it makes sense for me to be on campus when I have leg affairs and personnel back-to-back but not if it only one thirty-minute meeting on Fridays because most students are not even on campus and especially not at 9 AM so in making it virtual it is more accessible so I think that is something that we should be looking to.
- **Diana Chavez:** Although I have been stern about coming back in person that is why we are discussing it now because I want to hear your concerns. If I were to give that leeway to most of you, I don't want you to get your hopes up and then in the middle of the semester we are going fully in person.
- **Analiz Marmolejo:** I don't know if Aaron or Barnaby are in conversations, we haven't been in, but it is also looking like they are making a lot of classes virtual. So, I don't think that we should be completely in person next semester.
- **Diana Chavez:** It is all about meeting the needs of the students and if that means we have to be hybrid then again, I am open to that, but we are going with the flow and what is currently the plan and we are still having conversations on what should happen is anything changes.
- **Josue Montenegro:** I just wanted to ask how ASI handle one line-item meetings before the pandemic?
- **Diana Chavez:** We historically never have had a one-line-item agenda and if that happened, we would have to work on adding to it. I do want to work on what an agenda should look like.
